Rule Changes 30 July 2021

The CIHA Announces that the following amendments to the Rules of Racing have been made:

Manual (A)

1. Schedule 1 is amended as follows:

Registration of bespoke colours under Rule (E)68.1.3 has been added with a fee of £1,500.

Manual (B)

2. Rule (B)29 (requirement for horses to be ridden before the Judge's box before proceeding to the start) has been deleted.
3. Rule 30.1.3 is deleted in consequence of the above amendment.
4. Rule 36.3 (draw) has been deleted.
5. Rule 45.1 (stop race flag). The colour has been changed from red to orange and yellow quarters.
6. Rule 69.1.2 shall be amended to read "will be decided by at least three Stewards".
7. Schedule 4 paragraph 6.1.1. The words "except a hood" have been inserted so that the paragraph reads:

"if no declaration has been made under Paragraph 3 in respect of an item listed in Paragraph 3.1 (except a hood), the horse must not wear the item on the way to the start or during the race".

8. New paragraph 6.3 has been inserted as follows:

"A Trainer may request permission from the Stewards for a horse to wear a hood of a specified colour on the way to the start, but it must be removed by the Trainer (or their representative) before the horses are called in by the Starter and it must not be worn during the race otherwise the horse shall, on an objection to the Stewards under Part 7, be disqualified."

Manual (E)

9. In Rule 2.1, the following shall be added to the definition of Export Certificate:

"and in relation to a horse foaled in Great Britain, Ireland or the Channel Islands which has been permanently exported to another Racing Authority means the above certificate of pedigree issued prior to its first export and endorsed by each Racing Authority that the horse has been permanently exported to.

Manual (F)

10. Rule 52.4 (No declaration of Rider shall be accepted after the deadline specified in Paragraph 52.3) has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“If a declaration of Rider is not received by the time required, the Authority may authorise a Rider to ride a horse that is declared to run up to forty-five minutes before the start of the race.”

11. In Rules 75.1, 75.2, 80.4 and 88.2 all references to Schedule 12 shall be replaced with equivalent references to the scale of weight for age allowances published by the British Horseracing Authority from time to time.
