## Whip Review Committee

On Friday 15 August 2025 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (B)50 following its own independent review of races at Les Landes, Jersey on 10 August 2025. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

### Race 1, 10 August 2025 – The Westwood Bloodstock Sprint (6f)

Freddie Tett, the rider of GEMCUTTER (GB), was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from approximately one and a half furlongs out. In accordance with procedure, Mr Tett was invited to provide a written response to the Committee within 48 hours, which he duly did. The Committee then reconvened on Monday 18 August to consider his response which did not alter the Committee's findings. Allowing for the fact that Mr Tett has not committed any whip breach during the 2025 season in the Channel Islands, mitigation on penalty was applied and he will be issued with a caution.
