RACE 1 - 6.30pm	Handicap Hurdle	Two Miles & One Furlong
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Nothing to report.

RACE 2 – 7.05pm	Handicap	Five Furlongs
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Georgia Dobbie, rider of NEW CHARTER (GB), was unseated after the line. Miss Dobbie reported that the horse had jinked and unseated her. She was examined by the Racecourse Medical Officer and passed fit to continue to ride.

RACE 3 – 7.40pm	A Handicap	Seven Furlongs
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It was reported that a horse had stumbled towards the end of the back straight. The Chief Steward and Clerk of the Course examined the area and carried out some remedial work to the ground to allow racing to continue.

Race 4 - 8.15pm	Handicap	One Mile & One Furlong
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Nothing to report.

Race 5 - 8.50pm	Handicap	One Mile & a Half
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Matthew Lloyd Slater, rider of CASARUAN (GB), dismounted when pulling up. He reported that the horse had jinked. The horse was examined by the vets and was fine.

Post Racing

The Stewards noted that James Moon had failed to send his representative to attend an enquiry carried forward from the previous meeting. It was noted that Mr Moon had withdrawn his two runners in the first race at 14:06 and was not at the meeting. No reason had been given for the withdrawals despite a request from the Chief Steward. In addition, it was noted that Mr Moon had again failed to declare riders on either of his horses DANSEUSE DU SUD (FR) and JOYFUL VOICE (FR) and had, again declared two horses with the same colours.

The Stewards fined Mr Moon, in absentia as follows:

For the breaches of Rule (F)52.3 (failure to declare a rider - mandatory penalty):

12 June – Category B – First Offence - £120;

26 June - Category B – Second Offence - £240 (DANSEUSE DU SUD (FR));



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26 June - Category B – Second Offence - £240 (JOYFUL VOICE (FR));

For breaches of Rule of Rule (E)66.3 (declared two horses with the same colours - mandatory penalty):

12 June – Category A – First Offence - £75;

26 June - Category A – Second Offence - £150;

For breaches of Rule (B)79.1 (failure to attend an enquiry – entry point) - £2,000;

For breaches of Rule (F)54 – Non-runner after 12pm on the day of the race without explanation - £100 per horse (mandatory penalty).
